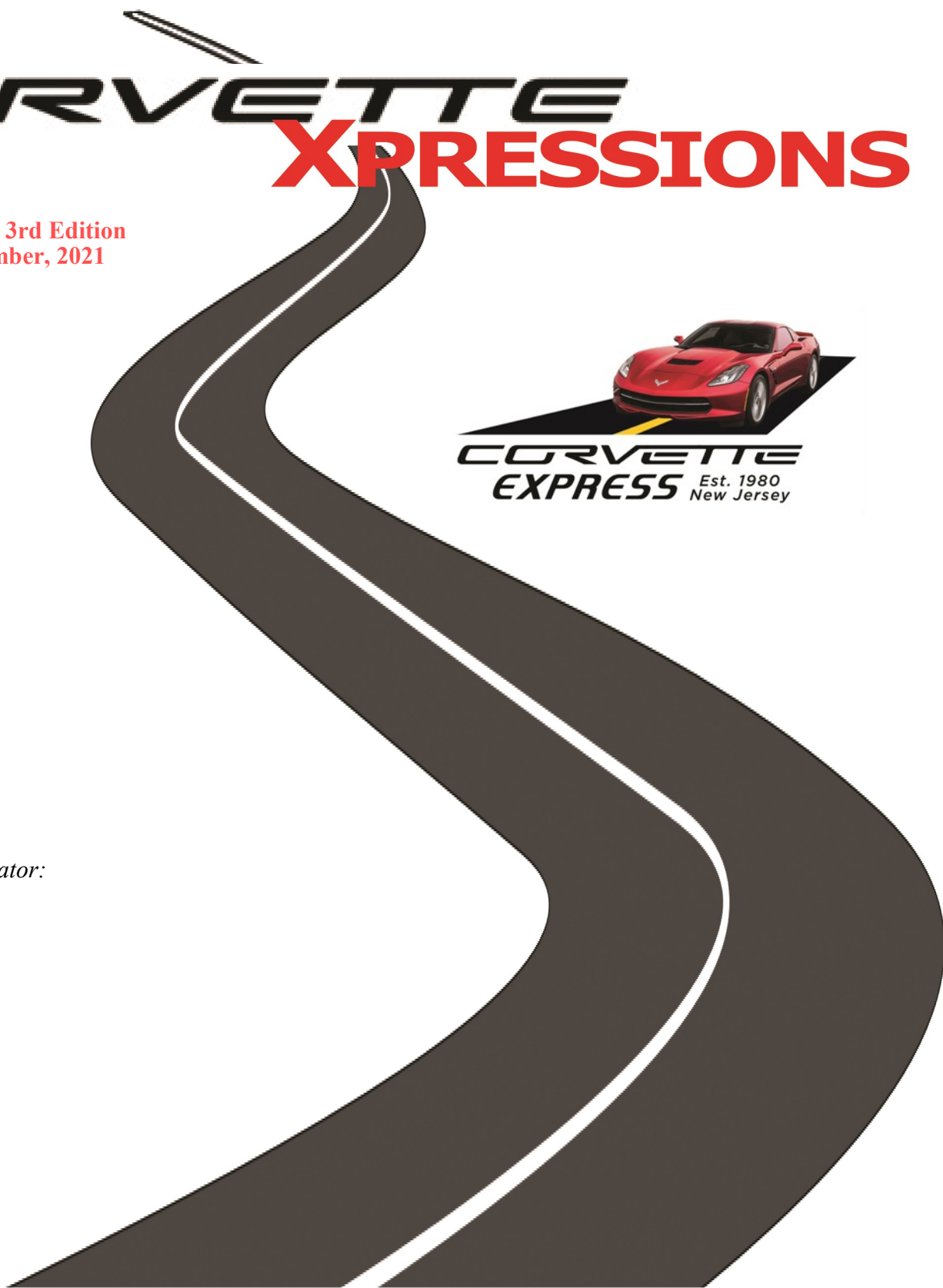

This Novice Class is designed for those eager to compete in Open Track events. You will gain knowledge on how to properly negotiate a road course as well as learn the proper preparations for racing. It will increase your day to day driving skills, teach you the basics of car control and prepare you for high performance driving. In the classroom you will learn everything from proper braking techniques and apexing to track preparation and much more.

The class will be broken down into smaller groups so everyone has plenty of time on the track. You will have an instructor go over what you learned in class and will stress the importance of being smooth.

There is more open track time with follow the leader, instructors and open driving. At this point, they are looking to see how comfortable you are. Upon completion you will be marked in the system with an RP (Raceway Park) License and receive a certificate of completion to participate in future Open Track events.
