

Part: OEM replacement ACDelco manufactured Mobile 1 DEXOS OW-40 Oil Cap w/ gasket Part number: GM 12686472 (FC265)

Application: All C7 Wet sump oil system (i.e. all without Z51, Not GRANDSPORT, Not Z06, Not ZR1)

Condition: New, unused, in opened original part bag **Price:** \$9.00



GM (Service Bulletin No. 18-NA-129, April 2018) states Mobile 1 DEXOS2 SAE OW-40 can be used for all oil changes of all C7 generation corvettes. Some on Corvette Blogger suggest replacement of the original oil cap with one like this one if you want to ensure servicing technicians use your preferred oil in your car. So there is a different part number for Z06 (FC 264, GM 12680708) for the Dry sump engine equipped models, which I have. I ordered the wrong part originally, and now want to sell the FC265 oil cap.
