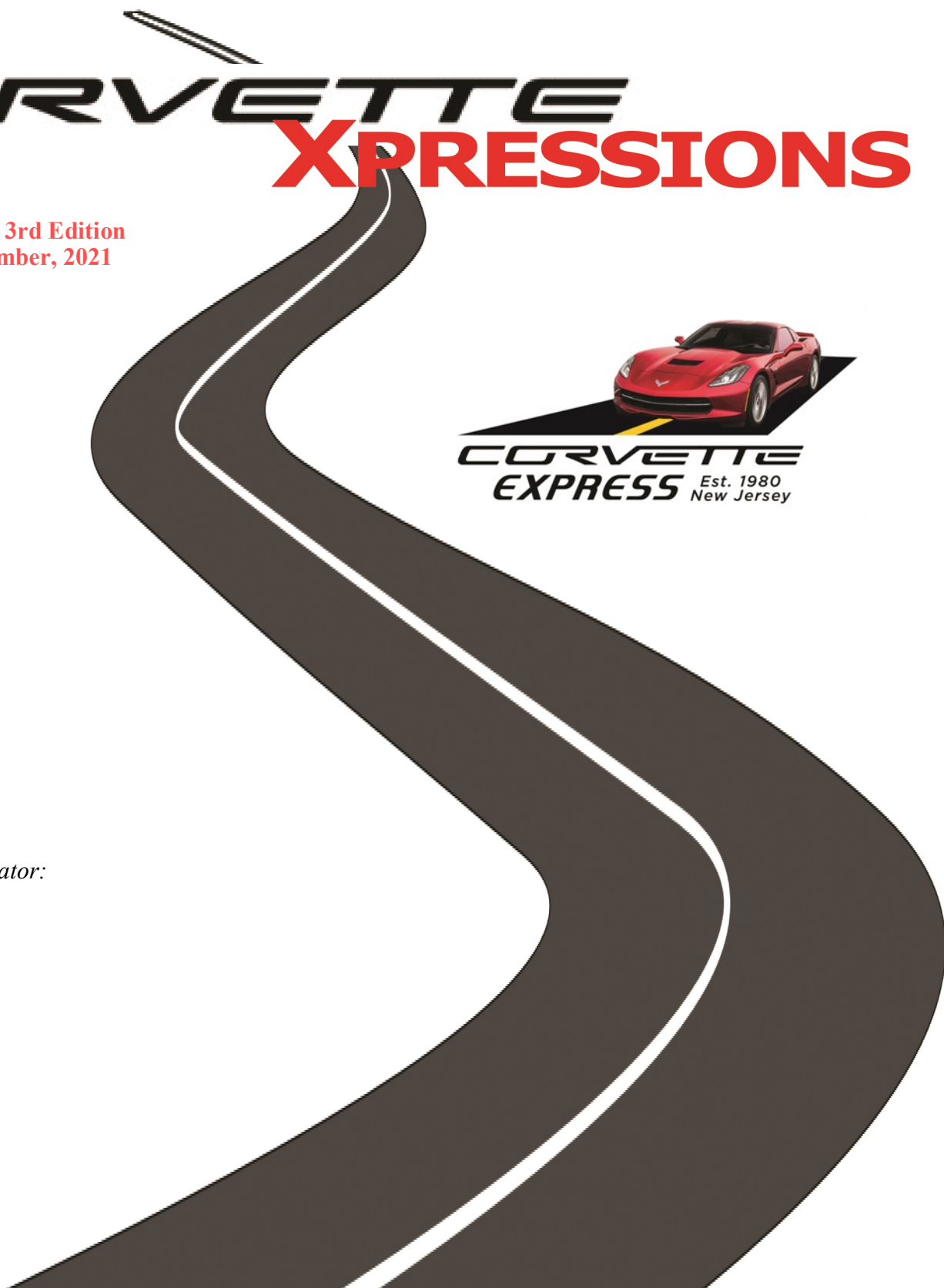

In Memoriam



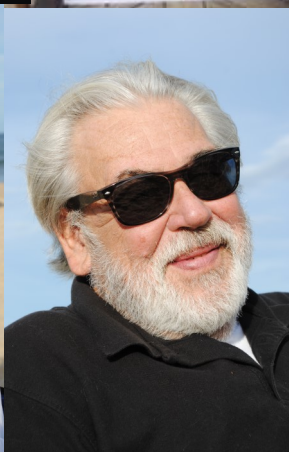
